- ⇒ Use ICT to find out more and present your work
- ⇒ Write a biography of a person of interest
- ⇒ Think of your own idea about how to present your work.

Please focus on the presentation of your work as it is really important that you are proud of your work, and that you produce the best work possible. We will be holding a display of all the projects in two special exhibition evenings so that all children and parents will be able to look at the range of work submitted. The exhibition for children in Byron (Red) and Chambers (Blue) will be on Tuesday 25th April and for children in Lyons (Yellow) and Perceval (Green) on Wednesday 26th April - both exhibitions immediately after school at 3.30pm in the Junior Hall.
