Dear Parent/Carer,

I am pleased to invite you to a special assembly to award children who have gained their Maths Passport.

The Maths Passports were introduced last year with the aim of increasing children's enjoyment of mental maths as well as improving on their ability to calculate sums in their heads. Each passport has a set of objectives that must be completed within approximately 30 seconds in a given period of time. The objectives progress from simple to more advanced maths with each new passport. The children are then tested at least twice a week and once they are able to answer 10 questions in less than 30 seconds, their passport would be signed and dated by the class teacher. Once they achieve this three times, they move on to the next objective until they have achieved all the objectives in that particular passport.

Your child has now successfully completed one of these passports and has moved on to the next continent.
